COVID Protocols for Menino Arts Center 2022-01

Face coverings must be worn by visitors at all times in the arts center. The N95 mask is recommended.

Per the City of Boston's new vaccine mandate, as of Saturday, January 15, 2022, all visitors 12+ years old must show proof of having had at least one dose of a vaccine. As of Monday, February 15, all visitors must show proof of full vaccination.

All visitors will be queried if they have had any contact with COVID in the last 14 days, and whether they have had any symptoms in the last 24 hours. If yes on either question they may not enter the arts center.

All visitors must be disciplined about wiping down surfaces, and avoiding shared elevator usage.

General Social Distancing - ensure separation of 6 feet or more between individuals unless this creates a safety hazard due to the nature of the work or the configuration of the workspace.

We will ensure access to handwashing facilities on site, including soap and running water wherever possible, and encourage frequent handwashing; We will also provide alcohol-based hand sanitizers with at least 60% alcohol, which may be used as an alternative.

We will post visible signage throughout the site to remind all visitors of the hygiene and safety protocols. Alcohol-based hand sanitizers with at least 60% alcohol should be made available at entrances and throughout floor areas for workers.
